Osiligi Farm — a 50-acre model site — is ETB's operational base, demonstration ground and practical classroom, dedicated to equipping pastoralist communities with hands-on skills, research-backed practices and climate-smart technologies.

The Osiligi model

ETB responds to pressing challenges facing pastoralist regions — recurrent droughts, livestock losses, limited access to adaptive knowledge and weak value chains. A multidisciplinary team of agronomists, animal scientists, engineers and climate adaptation specialists works on-site, integrating applied research with real-world training. Our goal is to replicate the Osiligi model across all 15 pastoralist counties in Kenya — reducing livestock mortality, enhancing feed and food security, and increasing climate resilience.

What we offer

From Osiligi Farm's 50-acre demonstration site, ETB delivers an integrated pastoralist model — combining climate-smart fodder, large-scale feed storage, water infrastructure and improved livestock genetics.

01**Juncao & drought-resilient fodder**

35 of 50 acres under high-yield fodder including Juncao grass — up to 180 t/acre annually at 18.6% crude protein, feeding up to 20 cattle per acre.

02**Hay & silage fodder banks**

Seven modern fodder banks with combined capacity exceeding 1,000,000 kg — enough to support 2,000+ cattle for up to eight months.

03**Dams & rainwater harvesting**

Five fully operational dams enable year-round irrigation and sustain livestock even during severe drought. Training in dam construction and drip irrigation.

04**Animal fattening & feedlotting**

Aggregation from pastoralist communities, feedlot fattening under controlled nutrition, sale of whole animals, prime cuts and value-added meat products.

05**Breeding — Dorper & beef cattle**

High-quality Dorper sheep and beef cattle. Genetic improvement enhances meat yield and carcass quality; improved stock supplied to community farmers.

06**Pastoralist capacity building**

Hands-on training in fodder cultivation, silage/hay preservation, dam construction and rainwater harvesting — replicable across 15 counties.

Training & how to book

Osiligi Farm is a live 50-acre classroom — dams, fodder plots, silage banks and improved breeding stock all in one place. Book training for your cooperative, county or NGO and leave with skills you can put to work the next day.
